

# Parliamentary Bureau – Approval of Scottish Statutory Instrument

## Affirmative instruments

### [Wine \(Miscellaneous Amendment\) \(Scotland\) Regulations 2024 \(SSI 2024/Draft\)](#)

1. Under Rule 10.6.5, the Bureau is required to lodge the following motion—

**George Adam on behalf of the Parliamentary Bureau:** That the Parliament agrees that the Wine (Miscellaneous Amendment) (Scotland) Regulations 2024 (SSI 2024/Draft) be approved.

### Purpose

2. To amend retained EU law (REUL) relating to the marketing and production of wine and other wine products to (1) introduce rules that will regulate how products marketed as “ice wine” must be produced, which will include a definition of ice wine, and (2) update the lists of approved oenological practices that can be used to produce and conserve wine and other wine products marketed in Scotland.

### Consideration by committee

3. At its meeting on 13 December 2023 the Rural Affairs and Islands Committee agreed to recommend that the Regulations be approved. The Committee report was published on 20 December 2023.

### Decision

4. Business Managers are invited to note that the above motion will be lodged.
5. Business Managers should reserve their position if their party intends to speak against or oppose the motion.
