Education (Student Loans) (Miscellaneous Amendments) (Scotland) Regulations 2018 (SSI 2018/307);

Glasgow City Council Area and North Lanarkshire Council Area (Cardowan by Stepps) Boundaries Amendment Order 2018 (SSI 2018/308).

- 4. Climate Change (Emissions Reduction Targets) (Scotland) Bill (in private): The Committee considered further the delegated powers provisions in this Bill at Stage 1 and agreed to consider a draft report at a future meeting.
- 5. **Human Tissue (Authorisation) (Scotland) Bill (in private):** The Committee considered further the delegated powers provisions in this Bill at Stage 1 and agreed the contents of a report to the Health and Sport Committee.
- 6. **Transport (Scotland) Bill (in private):** The Committee agreed the contents of a report to the Rural Economy and Connectivity Committee.

7. **Scottish Crown Estate Bill (in private):** The Committee considered the delegated powers provisions in this Bill after Stage 2 and agreed to ask questions of the Scottish Government in writing on new section 14A of the Bill before considering a draft report at its next meeting.
