6. **Transport (Scotland) Bill (in private):** The Committee agreed the contents of a report to the Rural Economy and Connectivity Committee.

7. **Scottish Crown Estate Bill (in private):** The Committee considered the delegated powers provisions in this Bill after Stage 2 and agreed to ask questions of the Scottish Government in writing on new section 14A of the Bill before considering a draft report at its next meeting.
