3. **Pre-Budget Scrutiny 2017-18 - Scottish Funding Council:** The Committee took evidence from—

The Committee also asked the Scottish Funding Council for its position on legislative consent memorandum LCM (S5) 4 on the Higher Education and Research Bill.

During the session, the Convener noted that Fulton MacGregor and Ross Thomson were attending a fact-finding visit with the Scottish Qualifications Authority on behalf of the Committee as part of its pre-budget scrutiny.
