- 1. **Decision on taking business in private:** The Committee agreed to take items 6, 7 and future consideration of its draft report on the European Charter of Local Self-Government (Incorporation) (Scotland) Bill, in private.
- 2. **Subordinate legislation:** The Committee took evidence on the Corporate Insolvency and Governance Act 2020 (Meetings of Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisations) (Coronavirus) (No. 2) Regulations 2020 [Made affirmative] from—

Aileen Campbell, Cabinet Secretary for Communities and Local Government, Scottish Government.
