User Testing – Volunteers required

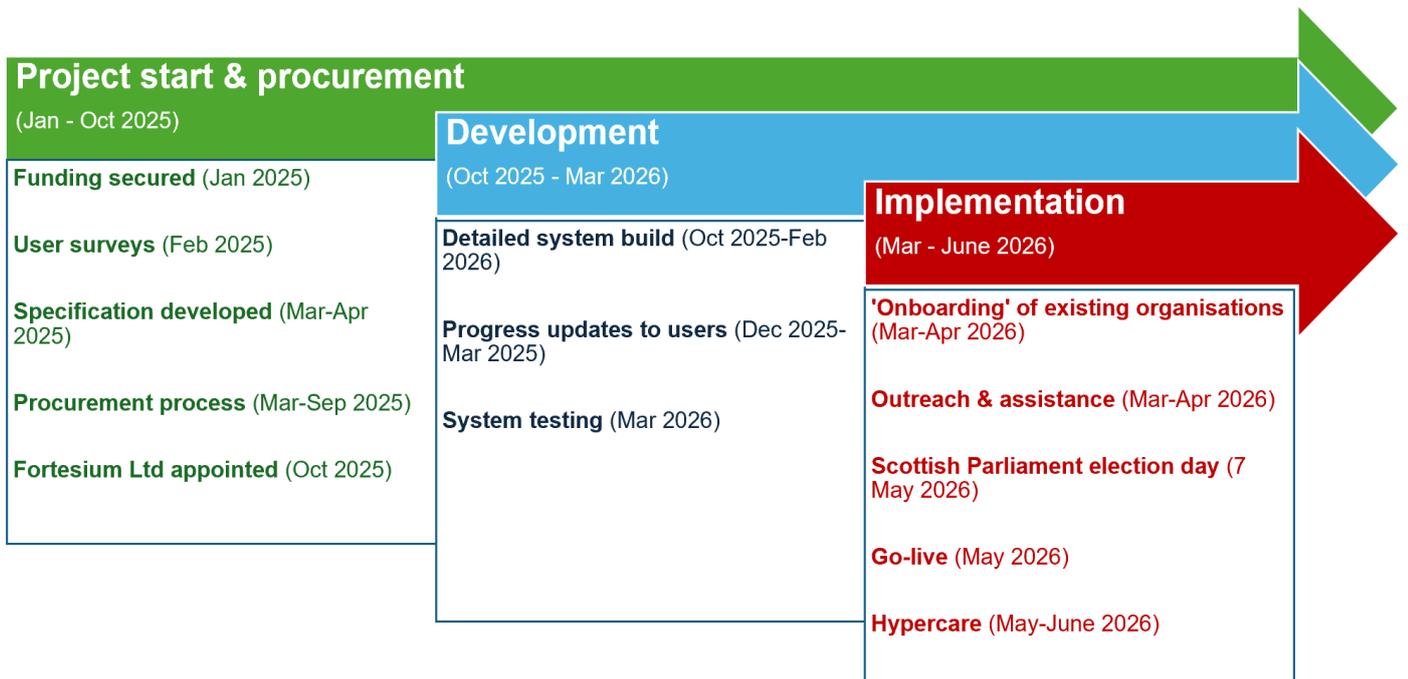
As we mentioned in our first report, we now seek expressions of interest to carry out testing exercises between Monday 23 March and Wednesday 1 April.
