Item 1: Minute of previous meeting and matters arising

- 1.1 The Advisory Group agreed the minute of the meeting held on 14 May 2025.
- 1.2 The Advisory Group noted the items agreed by correspondence since the last meeting:
 - Parents and Carers' Survey to be issued
 - Revised GSA illustration for public launch

Item 2: Update on progress on recommendations

- 2.1 The Group discussed the updates presented in the paper and noted the updates provided. This included:
 - Recommendation 3: The Group noted officials are working to progress the scheduled disability audit and agreed that further options for other aspects of Recommendation 3 should be considered at the next meet of the Group.
 - **Recommendation 4:** The Group agreed to continue to pursue this recommendation.
 - **Recommendation 5:** The Group agreed to follow up its correspondence with the Equalities, Human Rights and Civil Justice Committee in relation to this recommendation.
 - **Recommendation 6:** The Group requested officials follow-up on this recommendation and provide an update at the next meeting.
 - **Recommendation 7:** The Group noted the intention to launch the video at the Young Women and Democracy Summit on 19 September.
 - **Recommendation 13:** The Group agreed that officials should continue work on monitoring the relevant data.
 - **Recommendation 14:** The Group agreed to look again at this recommendation at their next meeting.
 - **Recommendations 15/16:** The Group noted that every effort should be made to give Members as much notice of late-sittings as possible, whilst acknowledging the unpredictability of parliamentary business.
 - Recommendation 17: The Group agreed to continue to monitor the predictability and family friendliness of parliamentary business.
 - Recommendation 34: The Group requested officials seek an update on this recommendation to bring back to the next meeting.
