Previous minutes and matters arising

1. The Bureau agreed the minutes of its meeting on Tuesday 24 October.

# **Business Programme**

- 2. The Bureau agreed to recommend to the Parliament a revised programme of business for the week commencing 31 October and a programme of business for the weeks commencing 6 and 13 November 2023.
- 3. 5. The Bureau agreed to recommend to the Parliament that Stage 2 consideration of the Trusts and Succession (Scotland) Bill be completed by Friday 24 November 2023.

#### Approval of a Committee Adviser
