Meeting of the Parliament

Tuesday 18 May 2021

The meeting opened at 2.00 pm.

1. Selection of the First Minister: The following members were nominated as candidates for appointment as First Minister—

Douglas Ross
Nicola Sturgeon

Abstentions	28

Nicola Sturgeon was duly selected as the Parliament's nominee for appointment as First Minister.

2. Urgent Question: An urgent question to ask the Scottish Government what engagement it has had with Police Scotland and Rangers FC regarding the reported COVID-19 regulation breaches, incidences of vandalism, violence and anti-Catholic bigotry in Glasgow city centre and at Ibrox Stadium on 15 May was answered by the Cabinet Secretary for Justice (Humza Yousaf).

3. Urgent Question: An urgent question to ask the Scottish Government whether it will provide an update on rising COVID-19 cases in Glasgow and parts of the Greater Glasgow area was answered by the Deputy First Minister (John Swinney).

4. Urgent Question: An urgent question to ask the Scottish Government, further to Greensill Capital entering administration, what action it is taking to mitigate the risks to jobs, vital industries and public finances in Scotland was answered by the Cabinet Secretary for Economy, Fair Work and Culture (Fiona Hyslop).
