I find the Scottish Government reply to be assuming that NHS Grampian has records, they don't and what they do have, NHS Grampian have confirmed to me that the system cannot be queried by location. To identify the information the Government require would require a manual trawl of individual records

That means they would have interrogated the system by each detainees name and date of arrest. We know NHS Grampian didn't attend the custody suite at Elgin so they wouldn't have completed any documentation.

Police Scotland have confirmed all healthcare was NHS Grampian responsibility, so they just followed orders and give the medication they were instructed to give. This was done without regard to whether it was licensed or not, whether informed consent was given or not. This more importantly was done with no documentation, utterly shambolic. detainees were triaged and medicated by medically unqualified Police custody staff, shameful.
