As part of our agreed reporting to the committee, I am writing to provide links to our end of January 2025 performance position. Please see our <u>status of open casework</u>, <u>casework turnaround times</u>, and <u>delivering the benefits of a complete land register</u> figures.

Other Key RoS Activities

As the Committee will be aware, I publish a monthly newsletter for customers and stakeholders highlighting the key RoS developments. For ease, I attach a <u>link to the</u> <u>January newsletter</u> for information.

As reported in last month's quarterly update, the 2024 Civil Service People Survey has concluded, and our results have now been published. We achieved a response rate of 83%, surpassing our target of 78%, and increased our engagement score by 2% to 67%. For reference the Civil Service benchmark engagement score in 2024 was 64%, a median score of the 103 participating organisations. A link to the <u>published report</u> is provided for information.
