Legislative Consent Memorandum: Cyber Security and Resilience (Network and Information Systems) Bill

The Economy and Fair Work Committee considered the [Legislative Consent Memorandum \(LCM\) for the Cyber Security and Resilience \(Network and Information Systems\) Bill](#) at its meeting on Wednesday 4 February.

The Committee notes that the Scottish and UK Governments do not currently agree on which aspects of the Bill require legislative consent, and that discussions between the two governments are ongoing.

The Committee recognises the vital importance of the issues covered by the Bill. It therefore welcomes the constructive dialogue taking place, and I intend to write to the Secretary of State for Science, Innovation and Technology to express the Committee's support for this engagement and its hope that an outcome acceptable to both governments can be reached.

I note your intention to lodge a supplementary LCM to update the Committee on these discussions before the end of the session. The Committee has therefore agreed to note the LCM in anticipation of this, at which point you will be invited to attend to outline the Scottish Government's position.
