EU Exit Legislation – Protocol with Scottish Parliament

The Scottish Parliament agreed on 18 June 2025, that it was content for Scottish Ministers to give their consent to extending the The Private International Law (Implementation of Agreements) Act 2020 powers for a further five years, as set out in the notification to the Parliament.

The SI to extend the Private International Law (Implementation of Agreements) Act 2020 Powers was made on 13 November 2025, bringing it into force on that date. The powers have been extended until the end of 12 December 2030. I can now confirm that this SI was consistent with the consent granted.
