RETAINED EU LAW REFORM - THE PROPOSED HEALTH CLAIMS (REVOCATION) REGULATIONS 2024

EU EXIT LEGISLATION – PROTOCOL WITH SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT

The Scottish Parliament agreed following notification on 19th of March 2024 that it was content for Scottish Ministers to give their consent to the Health Claims (Revocation) Regulations 2024, including Scottish devolved matters, as set out in the notification to the Parliament.

The Health Claims (Revocation) Regulations 2024 were sent for sifting at the UK Parliament on the 19th of March 2024 and were due for laying in June 2024. However, following the election of a new UK Government in May 2024, this process was suspended. Following an update from the Department of Health and Social Care on the 28th of January 2026, I can now confirm that this SI will no longer be progressed by the UK Government.


Food Standards Scotland and the Scottish Government are content that this SI does not need to be made.
