Thank you for your correspondence of 2 May 2023 regarding the follow-up actions of the Net Zero, Energy & Transport Committee from 25 April 2023.

I write to you to provide clarification in relation to whether there are any hospitals within the four proposed Scottish Low Emission Zones (LEZs) (Aberdeen, Dundee, Glasgow and Edinburgh).

At the committee, it was stated that there are no hospitals within the four LEZs. I can confirm that this is indeed correct with regard to general hospitals, i.e. those with inpatients. However, there are a number of medical facilities for outpatients within LEZs that may be of interest:

<u>Glasgow</u>

The Dental Hospital on Glasgow's Sauchiehall Street (not what most people would regard as a general hospital)

<u>Aberdeen</u>

Marywell Healthcare Centre

Edinburgh

Out-patients at Lauriston Building - services include dermatology, dental services, dietetics, ENT (ear, nose and throat), orthopaedics. Chalmers Sexual Health Centre Edinburgh Eye Pavilion
