Thank you for your letter of 4 July 2023 seeking clarity on the policy responsibilities which fall within my Transport, Net Zero and Just Transition portfolio and apologies for the delay in responding.

As requested, attached at Annex A is a table which sets out the responsibilities which I lead on as well as those within my portfolio which are delegated to junior Ministers (noting that some of these Ministers have additional responsibilities within other Ministerial portfolios).

On your specific queries, I have noted below who leads on each of the issues you have highlighted:

- 1. NatureScot; *Minister for Green Skills, Circular Economy and Biodiversity (Lorna Slater)* reporting to me (on biodiversity aspects and for support on corporate governance aspects which sit within my area of responsibility) and the Cabinet Secretary for Rural Affairs, Land Reform and Islands (Mairi Gougeon) (on peatland restoration and wildlife aspects).
- 2. Fuel poverty *Minister for Energy and the Environment (Gillian Martin),* reporting to the Cabinet Secretary for Wellbeing Economy, Fair Work, and Energy (Neil Gray).
- 3. Land reform Cabinet Secretary for Rural Affairs, Land Reform and Islands.
- 4. Cross-government delivery of 20-minute neighbourhoods *Minister for Community Wealth and Public Finance (Tom Arthur)*, reporting to the Deputy First Minister and Cabinet Secretary for Finance (Shona Robison).
- 5. Energy Efficiency, Heat networks, heating and domestic energy transformation and the Heat in Buildings programme *Minister for Zero Carbon Buildings, Active Travel and Tenants' Rights (Patrick Harvie),* reporting to me.

On energy policy, as noted above, while the majority of this work falls within the remit of the Cabinet Secretary for Wellbeing Economy, Fair Work and Energy and sits with the Minister for Energy and Environment, responsibility for energy efficiency, heat networks, heating and domestic energy transformation and the Heat in Buildings Programme sit with the Minister for Zero Carbon Buildings, Active Travel and Tenants' Rights, as part of my portfolio.

Annex B provides clarity on Mr Gray's portfolio in terms of where the energy aspects sit and what these cover. I have marked these in italics. It also includes the responsibilities of the Minister for Small Business, Innovation & Trade, who reports to me on key aspects of the Just Transition, including the delivery of the Just Transition Fund, liaison with the Just Transition Commission, and the Just Transition Plans and monitoring frameworks, as well as other aspects of the Green Economy, which are listed (highlighted in green) with his other responsibilities.

More generally, I wish to emphasise my overall responsibility for the Just Transition brief, which is closely tied to how we meet our net zero and climate resilience ambitions. This covers our Just Transition Plans and broader approach to tackling climate change in a way that demonstrates fairness, ensures we grasp the economic opportunities of the transition, and work with those likely to be impacted to bring them on the net zero journey.

The First Minister also announced a strengthening of the Ministerial team on transport with the appointment of Fiona Hyslop MSP as Minister for Transport on 13 June 2023.

In making this announcement, the First Minister confirmed an expansion to the role of transport within Cabinet, and I now take a greater day to day role in the portfolio as Cabinet Secretary for Transport, Net Zero and Just Transition.

Within the transport portfolio itself, I share responsibilities with the Minister and I maintain overall strategic responsibility, with the Minister responsible for delivery and operational matters. A breakdown of transport responsibilities can also be found at Annex A.

On a general point, I acknowledge that this split in responsibilities across Cabinet Secretaries and Ministers is complex. However, if we are to deliver for the people of Scotland, as set out in our recently published policy prospectus, we need a coherent, joined up government with shared responsibilities and collaborative working across Ministerial portfolios.

I hope this is helpful.
