## **MV Glen Rosa**

I note <u>your response</u> to my <u>02 April letter</u> received on 16 April. I also note that my 2 April letter followed <u>FMPG's 31 March quarterly update</u>, which contained no substantive detail on the timeline and updated costs for the MV Glen Rosa, despite a clear earlier undertaking to provide this information; and indeed to do so, if possible, by end January.<sup>1</sup>

Given the public interest for island communities and the very substantial taxpayer investment in the FMPG yard to deliver this vessel, the Committee found this omission frustrating and disappointing. I am writing once again to request that information.

In light of this, I ask for a response by **Tuesday 13 May** setting out clearly:

- 1. An up-to-date timeline for the delivery of the MV Glen Rosa including an expected handover date.
- 2. An up-to-date Forecasted Cost to Complete.

If there are specific reasons that, in your view, mean that you cannot provide this information, it would be helpful if you could set these out so that the Committee may be aware of them.

Should the information referred to in Points 1 and 2 above not be provided by 13 May, the Committee invites FMPG to give evidence on them on **Tuesday 20 May**.
