CONSULTATION DRAFT OF THE JOINT FISHERIES STATEMENT

I would like to thank you for the response provided by the Committee with regard to the Joint Fisheries Statement (JFS) on 26 April 2022.

Given the nature of the Joint Fisheries Statement (JFS) and the need to work with the other Fisheries Policy Authorities to prepare and publish the final JFS, I will need to consider your recommendations and feedback in the round with counterparts from across the UK.
