GOOD FOOD NATION (SCOTLAND) BILL – SCOTTISH FOOD COMMISSION

Thank you for your letter, dated 6 June 2022, informing the Committee of the Scottish Government's intention to establish a new Scottish Food Commission to provide oversight of the Good Food Nation (Scotland) Bill.

As you are aware, the Committee, in its Stage 1 report, agreed that effective oversight of the good food nation policy, and accountability for the statutory good food nation plans, are essential to achieving the good food nation ambitions. The Committee recommended the bill should be amended to strengthen the oversight function, although we did not feel we were in a position to make a clear recommendation as to where this oversight function should sit.

In advance of the Stage 3 proceedings, and consideration of the relevant amendments, the Committee would appreciate further information about—

- the anticipated timescale for establishing the proposed Scottish Food Commission;
- the role of the proposed Scottish Food Commission regarding Scottish Ministers' (section 1) and relevant authorities' (section 7) duty to produce a good food nation plan;
- estimated capital and recurring costs to establish and operate the proposed Scottish Food Commission, noting the Financial Memorandum does not include any estimated costs for the Commission; and
- further information about the type of public body the Scottish Food Commission would be, with reference to the Scottish Government's <u>guide to public bodies in</u> <u>Scotland</u>. In particular, the Committee is keen to understand the relationship between the proposed Commission and the Scottish Parliament.

In order to inform the Parliament's consideration of these amendments at Stage 3, the Committee would appreciate a response by Monday 13 June.
