THE IVORY PROHIBITIONS (CIVIL SANCTIONS) REGULATIONS 2022 EU EXIT LEGISLATION – PROTOCOL WITH SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT

This letter updates the Committee on the above UK Statutory Instrument relating to devolved matters to which Scottish Ministers gave their consent following consideration by the relevant committee (Rural Affairs, Islands and Natural Environment Committee) as per the agreed protocol between the Scottish Government and the Scottish Parliament on Statutory Instruments likely to be within the competence of the EU at Exit Day.

The Ivory Prohibitions (Civil Sanctions) Regulations 2022 were made on 15th March and I can now confirm that this SI is consistent with the consent granted.

This amendment does not have any impact on the application to Scotland of any provisions in the SI as notified to the Parliament.
