THE CHEMICALS (HEALTH AND SAFETY) (AMENDMENT, CONSEQUENTIAL AND TRANSITIONAL PROVISION) REGULATIONS 2026

EU EXIT LEGISLATION – PROTOCOL WITH SCOTTISH PARLIAMENT

The Scottish Parliament agreed on 11th February that it was content for Scottish Ministers to give their consent to the Chemicals (Health and Safety) (Amendment, Consequential and Transitional Provision) Regulations 2026 including Scottish devolved matters, as set out in the notification to the Parliament.

The Chemicals (Health and Safety) (Amendment, Consequential and Transitional Provision) Regulations 2026 were made on 30th April under the powers conferred by sections 14(1) to (3) and (4)(b) and (e) and 20(1) of the Retained EU Law (Revocation and Reform) Act 2023. I can now confirm that this SI ***is consistent with the consent granted.***
