WELLBEING AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT (SCOTLAND) BILL - FINANCIAL RESOLUTION

As you may know, Rule 9.12 of the Parliament's standing orders requires me to decide, in relation to every Bill, whether a financial resolution is required. Under that Rule, a Bill that requires a resolution cannot proceed to Stage 2 until such a resolution has been agreed to and, if no resolution has been agreed to six months after the completion of Stage 1, the Bill falls.

I am writing to inform you of my decision that the Wellbeing and Sustainable Development (Scotland) Bill does require a financial resolution.

Only a member of the Scottish Government or a junior Scottish Minister may lodge and move a motion for a financial resolution. My understanding is that, if you wish to invite the Scottish Government to lodge a suitable motion, you should write to the Cabinet Secretary for Finance and Local Government (copied to the Minister for Parliamentary Business).
