This meeting was to reconstitute the CPG on Cuba where office bearers were elected to the roles set out. Kath Campbell would provide secretariat on behalf of Scottish Cuba Solidarity Campaign.

Kath Campbell thanked MSPs for working to reconstitute the group, provided an update on the political, social, and economic situation in Cuba and set out the plans of Scottish Cuba Solidarity Campaign for the year ahead in the face of Covid-19.

08/12/2021

At this meeting MSP members provided an update on the Covid-19 protocols in the Scottish Parliament, outlining the impact this would have on the ability of the CPG to meet in person, whilst agreeing that it would be positive for the CPG to meet and hold events in and around Parliament moving forward.

Kath Campbell provided an update from the region and spoke in detail about the impacts of the blockade on Cuban society and its economy. Kath also highlighted the potential visit of members of the Cuban embassy to be visiting Scotland in 2022 and it was hoped a visit would occur if circumstances allowed.

Further discussions on the year ahead took place and the Convener closed the meeting.

15/12/2022

The Convener welcomed all to the meeting which was attended by Carol Mochan MSP, Katy Clark MSP, Maggie Chapman MSP, Mercedes Villalba MSP, Kath Campbell of Scottish Cuba Solidarity Campaign, alongside Chris Costello and Eva McFarlane from the office of the Convener. There was a wide-ranging discussion about the challenges facing Cubans throughout 2022 but Kath Campbell also alluded to some of the progress being made with recovery from the Covid-19 pandemic.

It was highlighted by both MSP and non MSP members that there ought to be greater cooperation in 2023 between the CPG and SCSC to ensure that Parliamentary events can take part and to allow SCSC to bring its Caravan Against the Blockade to the Scottish Parliament.

It was agreed that the CPG would meet again before the end of the month and again in the early New Year, hopefully in the Scottish Parliament and the meeting was closed.
