The CPG also agreed for non-MSP members to be involved in a research project being conducted by the University of Aberdeen, looking at the legal and policy landscape of Scotland's marine environment..

4 February 2025 – The CPG had a presentation from Vivian Bjånesø Horgen, rector of Hordaland fylkeskommune/Austevoll vidaregåande skule, on the role of the school in Norway in developing the next generation of fisheries workers, as well as wider maritime skills and expertise.

The CPG then had an update from Dr Mitchell Lennan of the University of Aberdeen on the CPG research project discussed at the previous meeting – with an extra curricular research event planned for non-MSP members.
