Update on progress since last meeting. MSPs spoke about their work in the chamber raising the issue of Long Covid.

Long Covid Scotland have had a busy year. They have just had their first AGM. There are concerns that progress on Long Covid has been glacial. The group met with Jenni Minto, Minister for Public Health and Women's Health.

Long Covid Kids Scotland have been speaking to the Covid-19 Inquiry and gave an update on that. Raised concerns that there has been zero progress when it comes to children and young people with the condition, and they are being left to suffer in silence.
