Mental Health

- Paul Pearson (Poverty Alliance) and Peer Researchers from Maryhill Integration Network Mohammed, Juliet, Ishmael and Sekou shared their research into the impact of the asylum system on mental health and outlined recommendations to Scottish Government and local authorities.
- Presentation from Ghizala Avan and Mahdi Saki (Mental Health Foundation) on the work of MHF in increasing civic participation and mental health support for grassroots organisations.
- Members discussed the importance of further research into mental health for people seeking asylum and additional support, and also discussed the impact of detention in particular on mental health.
