## **Topics discussed:**

- **Pilot of Free Bus Travel for People Seeking Asylum – Wales**
  - Presentation from Andrea Cleaver at Welsh Refugee Council on learnings from the pilot.
- **Campaign - Free Bus Travel for People Seeking Asylum in Scotland**
  - Update on the campaign for free bus travel and lived experience from Simon, ambassador from VOICES Network and Sekou from Maryhill Integration Network Voices.
  - Members with lived experience shared their own experience and outlined the change this could make to their lives.
- **Impact of cost-of-living crisis**
  - Research from Poverty Alliance on the impact of the cost-of-living crisis on women's experience, acute impact on people seeking asylum who have no access to cost-of-living support.
- **Can this be done in Scotland?**
  - JustRight working on a legal briefing on the parameters and confirm it is within the gift of Scottish Ministers.
  - Update from Transport Scotland on what options are being considered, including a pilot in Glasgow.

- Discussion on existing concessionary travel schemes, devolved competence and power of lived experience contributions.
