

Social Security Administration and Tribunal Membership (Scotland) Bill – Printing changes after the Bill As Passed (SP Bill 68B) Session 5, 2020

Printing changes are changes to the text of a Bill for which amendments are not considered necessary, or which, relating to non-legislative text, cannot be made by amendment. Printing changes will not be made that would alter the legal effect of the Bill. Clerks are responsible for making a judgement in each case as to whether a printing change is appropriate. Further explanation of printing changes can be found in the [Guidance on Public Bills](#), paragraphs 4.45-4.47.

This document outlines the printing changes that have been made following publication of the Social Security Administration and Tribunal Membership (Scotland) Bill As Passed and prior to Royal Assent and publication of the Act.

Long title	1	4	The word “and” moved to before the words “the recovery” in line 5 to reflect the addition of new material into the long title by amendment.
1A	2	11 and 15	Parenthesis for the phrase “as the case may be” changed from commas to brackets to match style elsewhere in the Bill.
1B	4	6 and 10	Parenthesis for the phrase “as the case may be” changed from commas to brackets to match style elsewhere in the Bill.
2	7	34 and 35	Subsection (3) is sub-divided into two paragraphs that were erroneously numbered (i) and (ii) in the Bill As Introduced. This numbering has been corrected to (a) and (b).
9	20	20	The word “the” inserted before “second” to correct a minor drafting error.
9	20	31	The word “an” inserted before “ordinary” to correct a minor drafting error.
