

Bankruptcy and Diligence (Scotland) Bill

Printing changes after the Bill as Passed (SP Bill 27B) Session 6, 2024

Printing changes are changes to the text of a Bill for which amendments are not considered necessary, or which, relating to non-legislative text, cannot be made by amendment. Printing changes will not be made that would alter the legal effect of the Bill. Clerks are responsible for making a judgement in each case as to whether a printing change is appropriate. 7	16	15	The full stop at the end of line 15 was updated to a comma as there is a further paragraph following it. This error was present in the Bill from introduction.
