

Hunting with Dogs (Scotland) Bill

Printing changes after the Bill as Passed (SP Bill 12) Session 6, 2023

Printing changes are changes to the text of a Bill for which amendments are not considered necessary, or which, relating to non-legislative text, cannot be made by amendment. Printing changes will not be made that would alter the legal effect of the Bill. Clerks are responsible for making a judgement in each case as to whether a printing change is appropriate. This document outlines the printing changes that have been made following publication of the Hunting with Dogs (Scotland) Bill As Passed and prior to Royal Assent and publication of the Act.

5	5	1	Section title changed to “Exception: management of foxes below ground” to reflect the contents of the section.
17	17	4	The words “it must state its reasons” brought down a line in order to form the closing sentence to the subsection as a whole as opposed to attaching to paragraph (b). This is known as a subsection fallout.
