

Judicial Factors (Scotland) Bill

Printing changes after the Bill as passed (SP Bill 40B) Session 6, 2024

Printing changes are changes to the text of a Bill for which amendments are not considered necessary, or which, relating to non-legislative text, cannot be made by amendment. Printing changes will not be made that would alter the legal effect of the Bill. Clerks are responsible for making a judgement in each case as to whether a printing change is appropriate. Further explanation of printing changes can be found in the [Guidance on Public Bills](#), paragraphs 4.47-4.49.

This document outlines the printing changes that have been made following publication of the Judicial Factors (Scotland) Bill as Passed and prior to Royal Assent and publication of the Act.

| Section/Schedule | Page | Line | Printing change made and explanation |
|------------------|------|------|--|
| 10 | 8 | 23 | Word “means” moved from the end of line 23 to beginning of line 24 to correct drafting error in Stage 2 amendment. The change had no legal effect. |
| 17 | 12 | 26 | Remove word “to” to correct drafting error in Bill since introduction |
| 38 | 24 | 21 | Update cross-reference to subsection (4)(a) rather than just subsection (4) to clarify cross-reference (which couldn’t refer to any other paragraph). Present in Bill from introduction. |
| 41 | 26 | 19 | Delete “of” to correct drafting error in Bill from introduction |
| Schedule 2 | 34 | 10 | Full stop added at end of subsection (2) |
