<Pardons: compensation

- (1) The Scottish Ministers must carry out a review of the options for compensating those individuals subject to the pardon, or the legal representatives of such individuals.
- (2) The Scottish Ministers must publish within 12 months of Royal Assent a report on the review, setting out—
 - (a) the estimated costs of these options and
 - (b) recommendations on how best to achieve the aim of compensating for the harms suffered by those subject to the pardon.>

Section 4

Pam Duncan-Glancy

- 9 In section 4, page 2, line 21, at end insert—

<“another family member” means an individual who was not a member of the same household as a miner at the time of the commission of the offence, but was—

- (a) a parent or step-parent of a miner,
- (b) a child or step-child of a miner,
- (c) a sibling of a miner,
- (d) a grandparent of a miner,
- (e) an uncle, aunt, nephew, niece or cousin of a miner.>

Fulton MacGregor

- 2 In section 4, page 2, line 37, at end insert—

<“sibling of a miner” means an individual who has at least one parent in common with a miner.>
