arising from the mesh removal surgery, whether performed at the same time as the mesh removal surgery or afterwards,>

2 In section 1, page 2, line 3, at end insert—

<() For the avoidance of doubt, the surgery or procedures falling under subsection (4)(ab) are not required to be arranged before the date specified in the scheme under subsection (3)(c), provided that the mesh removal surgery was arranged before that date.>
