## Supplement to the Marshalled List of Amendments selected for Stage 3

### Section 7

#### Stuart McMillan

2 In section 7, page 6, line 2, at end insert—

<(1C) In a case where—

- (a) two or more trustees meet the description in subsection (1A)(a) and (b), and
- (b) the circumstances described in subsection (1B) apply to each of them,

5 neither (or none) of those trustees are, for the purpose of section 12, to be regarded as able to make a decision in respect of their removal.

(1D) Subsections (1A) to (1C) apply in relation to a trustee which is a partnership, company or other body corporate as they apply in relation to a trustee who is an individual but as if the references to the trustee being—

- 10 (a) a member of a regulated profession (or entitled to practise as such), and
- (b) appointed or assumed to provide professional services in relation to managing the affairs of trusts in the course of business,

15 were references to the individual who is (or was) a member of a regulated profession and provided such professional services to the trust as an employee or partner of the partnership or as an employee or director of the company or body corporate.>
