Scottish Parliament legislation: Session 6

This Fact Sheet lists all bills considered by the Scottish Parliament from the beginning of Session 6.

It is divided into bills currently in progress; bills which have been passed; bills which have received Royal Assent and become Acts of the Scottish Parliament; bills which have fallen; and bills which have been withdrawn. Each section is arranged alphabetically by bill title, and indicates the type of bill, the person or organisation that introduced it and the key dates in its progress.
