*S5M-18019 Alexander Stewart: Crossgates Primary Wins Mock Court Award—That the Parliament congratulates the P7 pupils from Crossgates Primary School, which is in Cowdenbeath, on winning the Advocacy Award at the 2019 School Mock Court Project in Edinburgh; understands that the cross-curricular initiative uses a mock court case to encompass a range of subjects, including art, journalism, debating and writing skills; notes that, with the assistance of their teacher, the children worked with staff from Fife Law Centre to prepare the case; acknowledges that they made their own gowns, which included the school tartan, and that their work included writing newspaper articles and creating art that showed the "solicitors" in court; recognises that this is the second successive year that the school has won this award; notes that it was the only winner from Fife, and commends all of the hard work and effort put in by the staff, pupils and parents.

*S5M-18018 Gordon MacDonald: Top Rating for Edinburgh Children's Partnership—That the Parliament welcomes the news that the Edinburgh Children's Partnership has become the first in Scotland to receive a "very good" rating from the Care Inspectorate following a recent inspection; notes that the partnership, which consists of the City of Edinburgh Council, NHS Lothian, Police Scotland and the voluntary sector, is responsible for providing services for children in need of care and protection; understands that the inspection spent five weeks evaluating the services provided and found that the partnership responded well when children and young people were at immediate risk of significant harm, and that more children were now being looked after in community settings as a result of planned initiatives to strengthen kinship care and keep children at home; recognises that the report also praised the use of a strengths-based approach that led to increased wellbeing for children and young people, and that multi-disciplinary throughcare and aftercare services were successfully providing support and independence to young people; acknowledges the positive service that the partnership provides for children across Edinburgh, and praises the efforts of the staff in achieving this outcome.

A member seeking to introduce a Member's Bill must first lodge a draft proposal, together with a consultation document (or a statement of reasons why consultation is not considered necessary). Subsequently, the member may lodge a final proposal, in broadly similar terms to the draft, accompanied by a summary of consultation responses (or the statement of reasons). The member secures the right to introduce a Bill to give effect to the proposal if the final proposal secures, within one month, the support of at least 18 other members from at least half the political parties or groups represented in the Parliamentary Bureau, and provided no indication is given that the Scottish Government or UK Government is planning equivalent legislation.
