**\*[S6M-05089](#) Willie Coffey: Congratulations to St Joseph's Church Clergy and Parishioners, Kilmarnock**—That the Parliament offers its warmest congratulations to the clergy and parishioners of the magnificent St Joseph's Church in Kilmarnock on the occasion of the 175th anniversary of the solemn opening of the Church on 13 June 1847; notes that the Church was built by Irish immigrants, many of whom, it understands, had come to Scotland seeking sanctuary from difficult circumstances and seeking work to support their families; recalls that the first priest in the town was the Reverend Thomas Wallace who worked tirelessly to construct and pay for the Church, sited at the top of what is now Hill Street; notes the "do anything they can do" attitude of the Irish in Kilmarnock, which lives on today in a spirit of generosity, forgiveness and concern for those in need; congratulates Father Stephen McGrattan and all of the clergy and parishioners for organising a wonderful commemorative Mass of Thanksgiving at St Joseph's involving other Christian denominations in the town; notes in particular the beautiful composition, *Ite ad Joseph (Go to Joseph)*, by Dr Raymond McCluskey, which was performed for the first time, and wishes all of the community associated with St Joseph's many more years of peaceful and respectful worship.

**\*[S6M-05053](#) Ariane Burgess: Communities Housing Trust Wins Responsible Housing Award**—That the Parliament congratulates the Communities Housing Trust (CHT) on winning the Responsible Housing Award for coordinating their Regenerating A Rural Highland Community project in Achtercairn, Gairloch; understands that CHT won the "More than a roof – supporting communities of equal opportunities" category; commends CHT for, it believes, tackling depopulation in the Highlands by building 25 homes, delivered in partnership with Albyn Housing Association and the Highland Council; understands that the home tenures include social rent, low-cost home ownership and rent to buy; celebrates the building of a new tourist information hub and facilities that provide training from University of the Highlands and Islands and the Air Training Corps; acknowledges that the new tourist information hub is the first public building in Scotland to be awarded Passivhaus status; recognises what it sees as the importance of developing 20-minute neighbourhoods across Scotland and tackling depopulation in rural areas, and wishes CHT all the best for their future projects across Scotland.

**\*[S6M-05028](#) Ariane Burgess: Anti-nuclear Conference in Vienna**—That the Parliament notes that the first meeting of the parties on the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons is to take place in Vienna from the 21 to 23 June 2022; understands that this is the first annual meeting of the 62 countries who have signed up to the treaty since it came into force on 21 January 2021; recognises that the treaty prohibits the development, testing, production, stockpiling, transfer, use and threat of nuclear weapons; considers that it is a key step in achieving a nuclear weapon free world; believes that nuclear weapons are morally wrong, and that Scotland should be a nuclear-free country; condemns the UK Government's failure to sign the treaty and its ongoing commitment to a UK-based nuclear deterrent, and commits, should Scotland be independent, to signing the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons at the earliest available opportunity.

**\*[S6M-04980](#) Paul McLennan: Close the Gap's New Think Business Think Equality** —That the Parliament welcomes the reported launch of new, free resources to address sexual harassment in the workplace; understands that these have been developed by Close the Gap, which it considers to be Scotland's women and the labour market expert; recognises that the resources form part of Think Business Think Equality, Close the Gap's online self-assessment tool for small and medium-sized enterprises, which are designed to support them to advance, and benefit from, gender equality in their businesses; understands that the new resources include guides on how to develop a policy on sexual harassment, deal with reports of sexual harassment, and create a workplace culture that prevents it from happening in the first place; believes that there is a need for this resource, in light of reports that over 70% of women reported having experienced or witnessed sexual harassment in the workplace in Scotland; encourages employers to utilise the tool to help improve their employment practices; considers that employers have a pivotal role in preventing violence against women; believes that creating a zero-tolerance culture to violence against women in the workplace and in wider society should be a priority for all, and welcomes the work of Close the Gap in this area.

The member secures the right to introduce a Bill to give effect to the proposal if the final proposal secures, within one month, the support of at least 18 other members from at least half the political parties or groups represented in the Parliamentary Bureau, and provided no statement is made that the Scottish Government is planning equivalent legislation.
