

Islands (Scotland) Bill

Supplement to the Marshalled List of Amendments selected for Stage 3

Amendment 3A below was lodged as a manuscript amendment under Rule 9.10.6. The Presiding Officer has decided under that Rule that amendment 3A may be moved at the meeting of the Parliament on 30 May 2018. Amendment 3A will be debated in Group 7 and will be called immediately after amendment 3 (on page 8 of the Marshalled List) and before amendment 29 (also on page 8).

- 3A** As an amendment to amendment 3, line 5, leave out from third <a> to the end of line 9 and insert <the Scottish Ministers, a local authority and any other Scottish public authority with mixed functions or no reserved functions must—
- (a) comply with the Shetland mapping requirement, or
 - (b) where Ministers or, as the case may be, the authority consider that there are reasons not to comply, provide in such manner as they consider appropriate, information about those reasons.>

- 3** After section 12, insert—

<Shetland mapping requirement

Shetland mapping requirement

- (1) There is to be a Shetland mapping requirement.
- 5 (2) When publishing in any form a document that includes a map of Scotland, a Scottish public authority must comply with the Shetland mapping requirement.
- (3) Where a Scottish public authority is unable to comply with the duty imposed by subsection (2), the public authority must publish, in such manner as it considers appropriate, information about the reasons why it is unable to comply with the duty.
- 10 (4) The Shetland mapping requirement is that, in any map of Scotland, the Shetland Islands must be displayed in a manner that accurately and proportionately represents their geographical location in relation to the rest of Scotland.>
