The meeting opened at 10.02 am.

1. **Subordinate legislation:** The Committee took evidence on the Community Care (Personal Care and Nursing Care) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2019 [draft] from—

Jeane Freeman, Cabinet Secretary for Health and Sport, Mike Liddle, Adult Social Care Policy, and Anne Mathie, Solicitor, Legal Directorate, Scottish Government.

2. **Subordinate legislation:** Jeane Freeman, Cabinet Secretary for Health and Sport moved—S5M-15752—That the Health and Sport Committee recommends that the Community Care (Personal Care and Nursing Care) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2019 [draft] be approved.

PE01568 by Catherine Hughes on Funding, access and promotion of the NHS Centre for Integrative Care, to keep the petition open and to bring it to the attention of relevant Cross-Party Groups. No further action in the meantime.
