**HMICS Assurance Review of Police Scotland's Counter Corruption Unit
Recovery of Disc Containing CCTV Images**

With reference to the above, I write to advise that the disc containing CCTV images reported as lost during the HMICS Assurance Review of Police Scotland's Counter Corruption Unit has now been found.

On 25 August 2016, an officer working within the CCU Intelligence Section was clearing their personal locker when they discovered the missing CCTV disc amongst the items within. The officer immediately informed their supervisors of the find.

The content has been viewed by senior managers from the CCU who confirm it is the missing disc, which has now been formally lodged as a production in line with relevant Police Scotland procedures.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, in terms of openness, transparency and independent oversight, I have also invited Derek Penman, HM Inspector of Constabulary in Scotland to view the content in order that HMICS is satisfied that this is the missing disc. I shall, of course, update the Committee once this has been done.
