COPY OF LETTER FROM JAMES DORNAN MSP

I am writing to you firstly to draw your attention to the matters raised in the letter which concern domestic arrangements in the Parliament and the duty of care to personnel. These are not matters for the Committee and I refer them to you for consideration.

With regard to the Committee's remit in relation to Members' conduct, Section 9 the Code of Conduct dictates that complaints of this nature are first investigated by Business Managers and, if unresolved, are then referred to the SPCB who may then refer it to the Standards, Procedures and Public Appointments Committee. In order to assure myself and the Committee that we are following procedures properly, I would be grateful if you would arrange for the SPCB to formally refer the complaint to the SPPA Committee.
