# **Subordinate Legislation**

Scotland Act 1998 (Agency Arrangements) (Specification) Order 2003 (SI 2003/407)

Housing (Scotland) Act 2001 (Payments out of Grants for Housing Support Services) Order 2003 (SSI 2003/140)

The Convener (Johann Lamont): I welcome members to this meeting of the Social Justice Committee, which I think we can safely say this time will definitely be the last one before Parliament dissolves.

Item 1 concerns subordinate legislation. Both statutory instruments that we have to consider are negative instruments, and so are subject to annulment under rule 10.4 of the standing orders. No motion to annul either instrument has been lodged with the chamber desk.

The committee has before it a copy of the Scotland Act 1998 (Agency Arrangements) (Specification) Order 2003 (SI 2003/407) and accompanying documentation. Are there any comments?
