Scottish Government Responses

The Convener (Jamie Stone): I welcome everyone to the 12th meeting of the Subordinate Legislation Committee in 2008. I hope that everyone in the room today has had a refreshing break. We have received apologies from Jackson Carlaw. I ask members to turn off any mobile telephones.

After our meeting on 25 March, we wrote to the Scottish Government about four Scottish statutory instruments, and members have now seen the responses.

Bankruptcy and Diligence etc (Scotland) Act 2007 (Commencement No 3, Savings and Transitionals) Order 2008 (SSI 2008/115)

The Convener: Are members content to draw the order to the attention of the lead committee and Parliament on the grounds set out in the summary of recommendations?

Police (Special Constables) (Scotland) Regulations 2008 (SSI 2008/117)
