



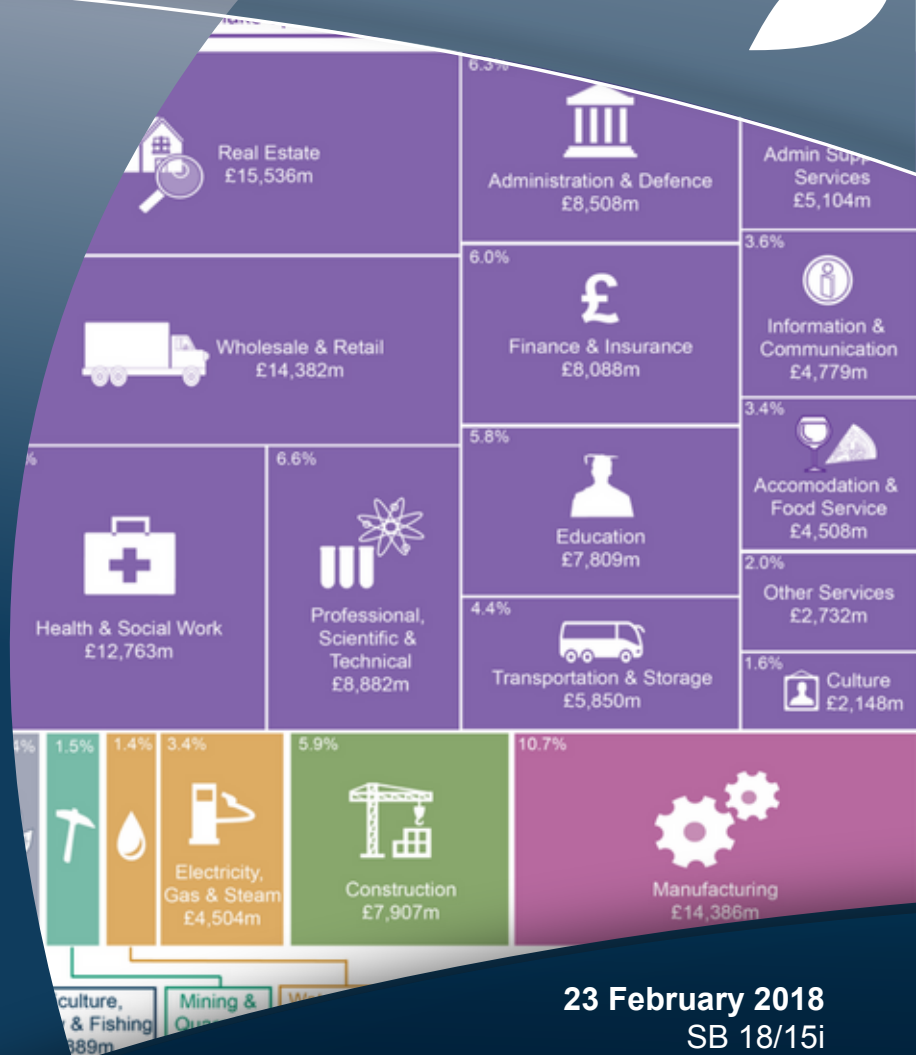

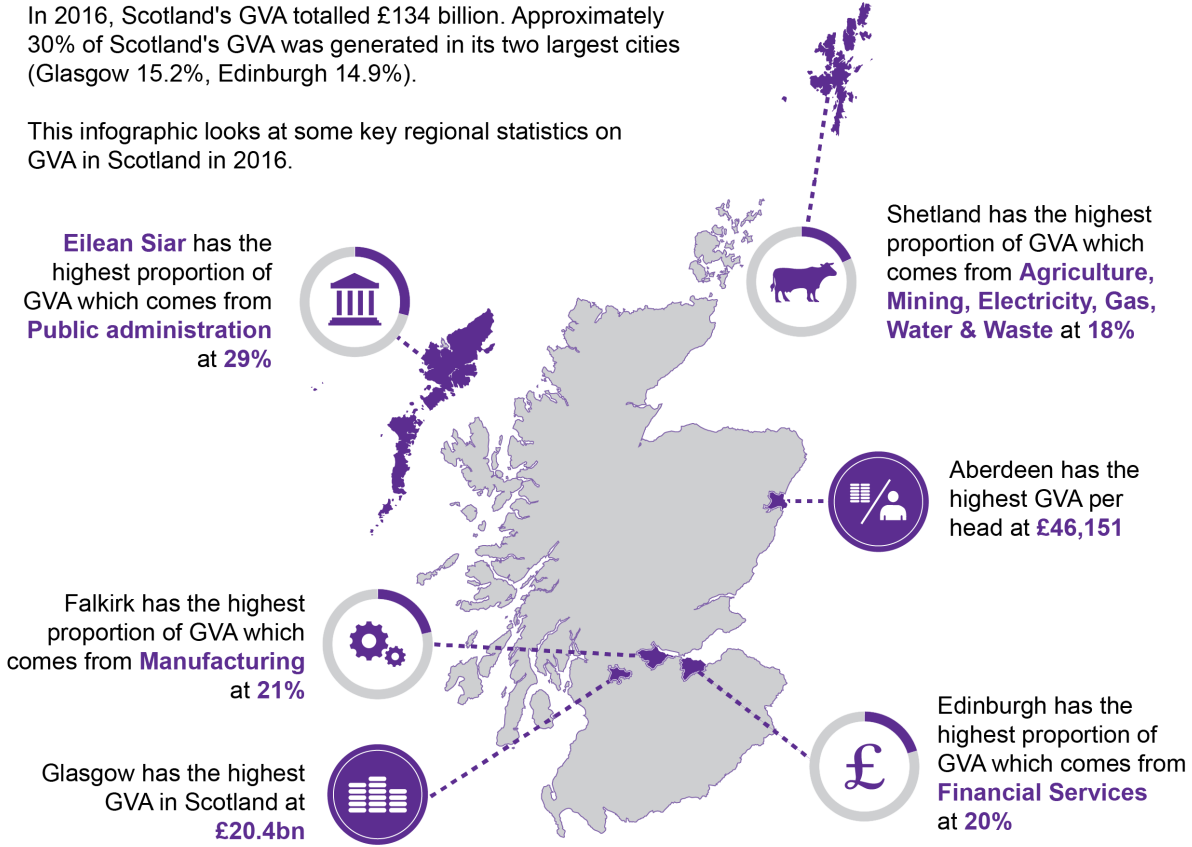

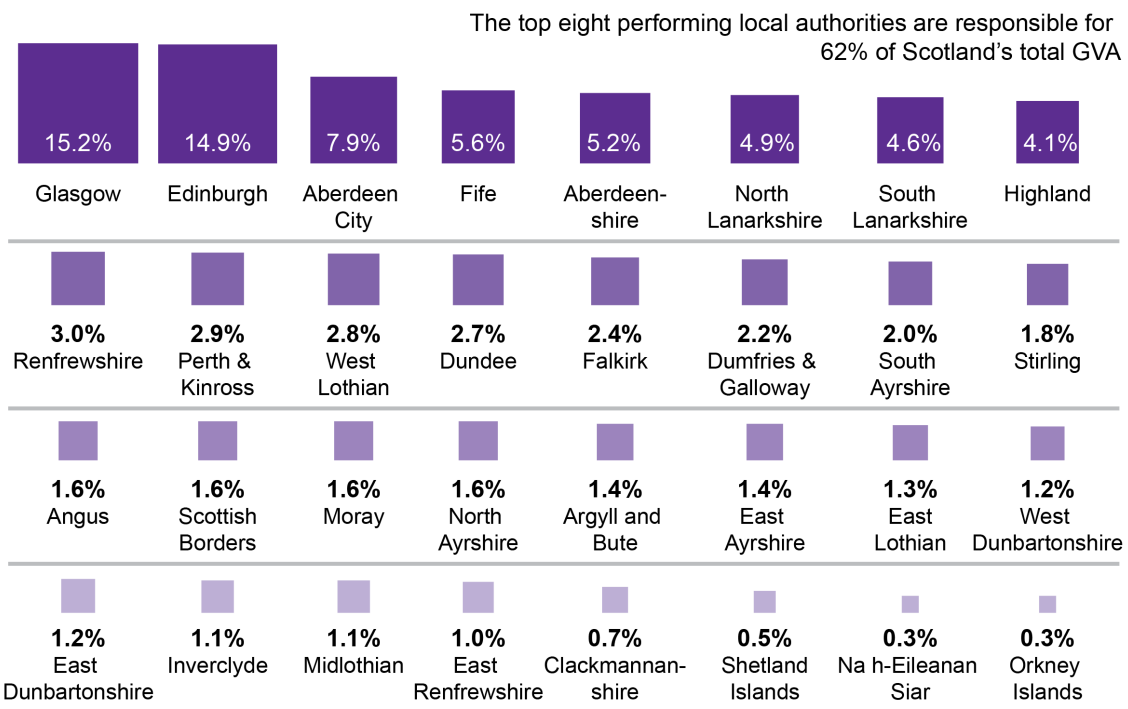
What does GVA look like across Scotland?

In 2016, Scotland's GVA totalled £134 billion. Approximately 30% of Scotland's GVA was generated in its two largest cities (Glasgow 15.2%, Edinburgh 14.9%).

This infographic looks at some key regional statistics on GVA in Scotland in 2016.

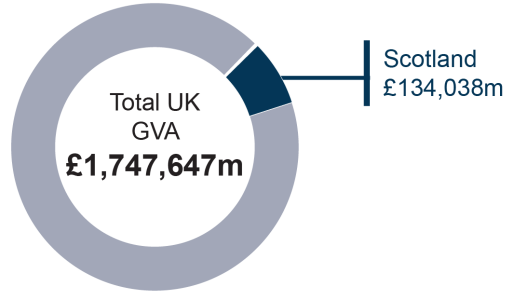

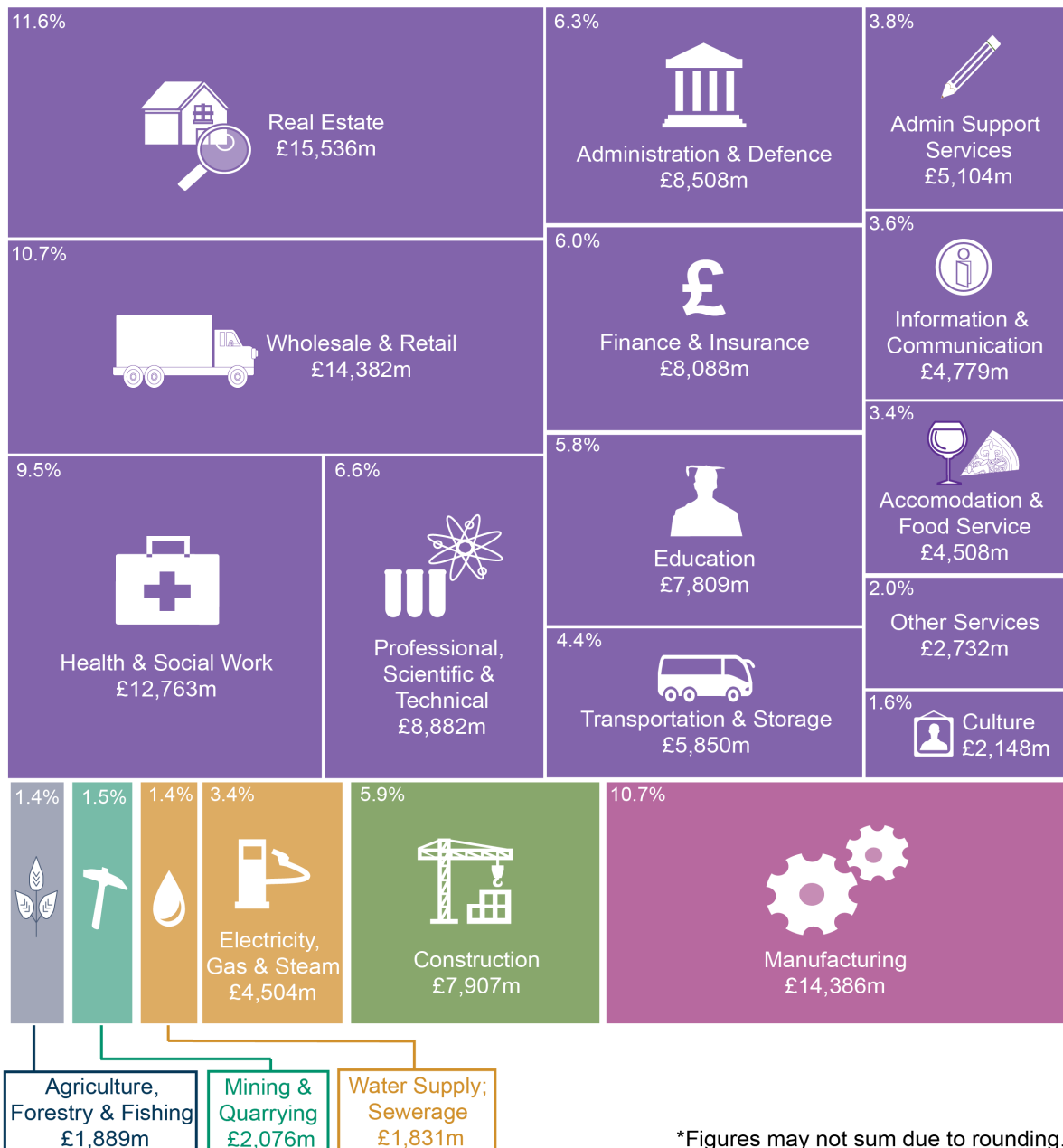
A Guide to GVA

GVA (Gross Value Added) across Scotland's broad sectors in 2016.

In 2016, Scotland's GVA totalled £134,000 million, which was 8% of the UK total.



How do broad sectors make up Scottish GVA? (value and % of total Scottish GVA)



What are the biggest changes in top level sectors GVA since 1998 until 2016?

Between 1998 and 2016 majority of sectors in Scotland grew in line with national trends.
