Introduction

National Strategy for Economic Transformation

- 3. The Scottish Government published its <u>National Strategy for Economic</u> <u>Transformation</u> (NSET) in 2022, setting out its economic priorities for the next decade. <u>Delivery plans</u> were published in October 2022.
- 4. The Deputy First Minister and Cabinet Secretary for Economy and Gaelic provided an update <u>in November 2024</u>. The most recent <u>NSET progress report</u> was published on 25 September.
