- 1. During this meeting, the Committee will undertake Stage 2 proceedings for the Terminally III Adults (Scotland) Bill ("the Bill").
- 2. Liam McArthur introduced the Bill in the Scottish Parliament on 27 March 2024.

- 5. The Committee published its Stage 1 report on the Bill on 30 April 2025.
- 6. The Bill ended Stage 1 on 13 May 2025, following a debate in the Chamber.
