Budget (Scotland) Bill Background

- 1. On 9 December 2021 the Scottish Government introduced the <u>Budget (Scotland)</u> Bill.
- 2. The Budget Bill is how the Parliament agrees public spending in Scotland. A Budget Bill is introduced to the Parliament every year.
- 3. This budget is for the financial year 2022-23.
- 4. The Committee wrote to the Scottish Government in October making recommendations on matters the Scottish Government should take into account in the preparation of the budget. A copy of that letter can be accessed via the link below.
