Coronavirus (Recovery and Reform) (Scotland) Bill

Note by the clerk

Introduction

- 1. The Scottish Government's <u>Coronavirus (Recovery and Reform) (Scotland) Bill</u> was introduced on 25 January 2022.
- 2. The COVID-19 Recovery Committee is the lead committee on the Bill.
- The Criminal Justice Committee is a secondary committee on the Bill and is going to be scrutinising the justice proposals in the Bill at Stage 1 of the Parliament's legislative process.
- 4. Although the remit of the Committee refers to criminal justice, the Committee will also be considering court measures that apply to both criminal and civil courts, and legal aid which is also a criminal and civil matter.
- 5. A <u>SPICe briefing has been published</u> on the provisions of the Bill on which the Committee will be taking evidence.
