Report of the Misogyny and Criminal Justice in Scotland Working Group

Note by the clerk

Introduction

- The independent <u>Misogyny and Criminal Justice in Scotland Working Group</u> was established to consider how the Scottish criminal justice system deals with misogyny. This included looking at whether there are gaps in the law that could be addressed by a specific criminal offence to tackle such behaviour.
- 2. The Group also considered whether a statutory aggravation and/or a stirring up of hatred offence in relation to the characteristic of sex should be added to the Hate Crime and Public Order (Scotland) legislation by regulation at a future date.
- 3. The Working Group published its report: Misogyny A Human Rights Issue, on 8 March 2022. The Scottish Government published its written response to the report on 21 April 2022.
- 4. The Committee will take evidence on the Working Group's report, as well as the Scottish Government's response.
