Choice of Convener

Purpose of paper

1. This paper explains the procedure for choosing a Convener following the departure of the previous Convener to the Committee.

Deputy Convener

 Standing Orders oblige all committees to choose a Convener following the departure of a previous Convener. Rule 12.1.13 states that, where the office of Convener is vacant, the meeting will be chaired by the Deputy Convener for the purpose of choosing a Convener.

Choice of Convener

- 3. On 15 June 2021, the Parliament agreed to motion S6M-00393 which resolved that members of the Scottish National Party are eligible to be chosen as Convener of the Health, Social Care and Sport Committee. The Deputy Convener will invite a nomination from members of that party for the convenership. There is no requirement for nominations to be submitted in advance of the meeting or to be seconded.
- 4. Committee members will then be invited to appoint the nominated person as Convener.
- 5. On being chosen by the Committee, the Convener will immediately take the chair and will chair the rest of the meeting.
